

Small Group Ministries at PGF

The primary objective of our small group ministry is to carry out the Great Commission of making disciples of all people using a two-step approach patterned after the New Testament to achieve that objective.

The first step is to “Share Life Together as Family.” Our small groups meet together in homes for Bible study, prayer and fellowship in a family context where we interact and share life experiences together as the “family” of God.

The second step is to “Serve our Community as Family on Mission Together”. Each member of the group contributes their unique, God-given gifts to work together with the other members of their home group to intentionally reach out to their own neighborhood with the love and the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Each home group has its own unique personality and style but common characteristics of these groups are as follows: they generally meet once each week in a home for interactive Bible study, prayer and fellowship. Often these weekly meetings include a meal together. As relationships develop each group will often meet together for other social or recreational events, to celebrate special occasions, to provide assistance to one another in times of need, and to reach out to neighbors with a demonstration of the love of Christ.

The home groups become a loving, safe, God-glorifying environment into which the group members are encouraged to invite unbelieving neighbors for the purpose of introducing them to the life and ministry of Christ expressed through the “family”. The discipleship process is carried out from introduction to Christ, through to salvation, and growth to maturity by each of the group members contributing their part in the context of the small group.
